7.68. Species Reference Data Changes:

Many listings in the original CBC data sets include references to a species or genus that [for practical reasons] is not necessary. For example, several references to “screech owl sp.” throughout the years leave the impression that perhaps a Western Screech-owl could have been a possibility. Though it is true that anything capable of flight is capable of landing in your own backyard, the likelihood of Western Screech-owl in Minnesota is too improbable to justify including it in the database. Conversely, a number of Loggerhead Shrike records have proven to be acceptable. Therefore a Lanius sp. category is included in the database. Regardless of how the final reference is listed in this database, all entries retain the original references as it was reported! This is maintained in a separate column of the CBC Data table. The following list includes references to species contained in the database that have been replaced with a more conventional reference.
